5. To make all necessary arrangements for **uploading the daily grievances** and further follow up.
6. To Prepare daily **feedback / appraisal** report for submission to the Hon'ble Chief Minister.
7. To make provision for **uploading of photos** of the Mandal team visit and people participation in the programme every day.
8. To issue guidelines regarding **Daily Report Format** and other activities to be uploaded by the teams in the JBMV website.
9. To provide GP/Ward Level **satisfaction survey report** on various programmes for discussion during the meeting.
10. To establish a **screen** at the venue in each GP and to arrange for the direct telecast of the Hon'ble Chief Minister live message to the public on the theme of the day. The AP Fibernet Corporation to assist and to make necessary arrangements.
